HB 2049: Improving Washington's solid waste management outcomes.

The Re-WRAP Act (HB 2049) is a comprehensive bill to modernize recycling in WA. It will shift the cost of recycling from residents to producers of packaging and paper, provide curbside recycling service to all Washingtonians. This is one of our three top priorities this session.

- Stops landfilling \$104 million in recyclable materials per year in Washington and reverses the downward trend in Washington's recycling rates.
- Makes it easier and more accessible for residents to recycle with a statewide list of recyclable materials, education for residents, and curbside recycling services for all Washington residents that receive garbage service.
- Shifts costs of recycling from residents to producers
- Reduces litter, plastic pollution, and carbon emissions

Please vote NO on amendments that may be offered by Reps Dye and Fey that will weaken the critical piece of the Re-WRAP Act: Producer Responsibility. Thank you.
