House Committee Action



House Committee on Environment & Energy: Public Hearing, Tuesday, 1/21 HB 1150: The Recycling Reform Act: Improving Washington's solid waste management outcomes.

- One of the 4 environmental community priorities for 2025
- Modernizes Washington's recycling system, making recycling accessible for all.
- Reduces excess packaging (including plastic), increases recycling, refill and reuse, creates a uniform recycling list, and reduces costs for local governments and residents across the state.



House Committee on Local Government: Public Hearing, Tuesday, 1/21. Executive Session, Friday 1/24

HB 1183: Concerning building code and development regulation reform.

- Would allow retrofits and passive housing to intrude into setbacks.
- Limits certain design requirements for affordable housing, retrofits, and passive houses.



HB 1303: Increasing environmental justice by improving government decisions.

House Committee on Environment & Energy: Public Hearing, Thursday, 1/23 Cumulative Risk Burden (CURB) Pollution Act reduces pollution by considering cumulative health risks and prioritizes protections to the most impacted communities.
