SB 5077: Concerning expansion of voter registration services by government agencies.

- Improves Washington's automatic voter registration (AVR) system by expanding it to voters returning from incarceration, gaining citizenship, and applying for Medicaid.
- AVR streamlines voter registration updates, increasing the accuracy of voter roll information
