VOTE EARLY

Return your ballot during the FIRST WEEK you receive it. Early voting protects your vote from mail delays, legal challenges, and last-minute confusion.

Illegal federal actions are trying to invalidate 15-20% of returned ballots.

USE A BALLOT DROP BOX

Return your ballot to an official ballot drop box at least one week before Election Day instead of mailing it. Drop boxes are secure, convenient, and eliminate concerns about postal delays.
