Make your voting plan



Facebook and LinkedIn: Sample Post

Are you ready to vote? Make a voting plan!

- ✓ Check your registration status. Update your information or register to vote if you aren't already.
- ✓ Decide how you'll vote. You can vote by mail or in person. Make sure you know the location of your ballot drop box or closest polling place.
- ✓ Decide when you'll vote. You can vote early or on Election Day.
- ✓ Research what's on your ballot. What candidates are running? What ballot measures are on the ballot?
- ✓ Remind your friends and family to vote. Make sure Native voices are represented!
